PE Update

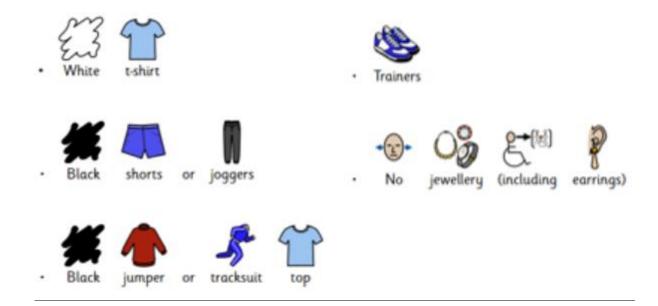
After half-term, we will be welcoming a specialist gymnastics coach who will be working with classes in Years 1 to 6 during gymnastics PE lessons. Please ensure that your child comes to school with their PE kit every Tuesday.

Additionally, our second PE lesson will focus on yoga, which promises to be a relaxing and beneficial experience for the children. To help you keep track, here's a rundown of when your child will need their PE kit:

- EYFS: Monday and Friday (children to come to school wearing PE kits on these days)
- Year 1: Tuesday and Wednesday (children to come to school wearing PE kits on these days)
- Year 2: Monday and Tuesday
- Year 3: Tuesday and Friday
- Year 4: Tuesday and Friday
- Year 5: Tuesday and Wednesday
- Year 6: Wednesday (This will continue to be swimming so please bring swimming kit)

After School Club collection

On Sunday 27^{th} October all clocks in the UK go back 1 hour. Please note that from Monday 4^{th} November all children attending an after-school club will need to be collected by an adult. This includes pupils in Year 5 and 6. If you have stated on your club application form, that your child can walk home alone, can you please email the school office to let us know who will be collecting your child next half term. Thank you.

Flu Vaccinations

The school nursing team will be in school on Wednesday 13th November to give children this year's flu vaccinations. The vaccine will help protect your child against fu and serious complications such as bronchitis and pneumonia. The vaccinations are given via a nasal spray which is easy to administer and painless. If you would prefer for your child to have the vaccine as a gelatine-free injection, please make this request when completing the consent form. This vaccination is offered to all pupils.
