Parent/Teacher consultations



Volunteer Work

We are delighted to have forged a good relationship with Unity Campus, the new science park in Pampisford. Not only are they able to offer support to us during both Careers and Science weeks but they are also able to provide much needed practical support around school site.

During the first week of the Easter holidays, week commencing 7th April, they will be providing volunteers and contractors to work across the school site in a number of much needed areas. They are going to work in both the EYFS outdoor area as well as in the pond area. They are able to provide machinery that will make the huge task much more manageable, and this will have a huge impact on both learning areas. We are hoping that this relationship with Unity and their contractors Countrywide will continue to grow and that they can support us with work in other areas of site at a later date.

On 9th and 10th April, they are also sending in a team of staff volunteers who are going to paint outdoor areas and do some gardening. We are hoping to be able to provide a team of parent volunteers to come in and work with the Unity volunteers, working outside of school, rubbing down benches/woodwork and repainting as well as some gardening and tidying.

Pancake Day/Ramadan

Pancake Day or Shrove Tuesday falls on Tuesday 4th March and marks the final day before Lent starts. Many people give up things such as chocolate or sweets for Lent which starts on Wednesday 5th March and ends on the day after Good Friday, Saturday 19th April.





Similarly, Ramadan starts at sundown today and lasts until Saturday 29th March. Ramadan is a month of fasting, prayer, giving and self-evaluation. During Ramadan, Muslim's will not eat between dawn and sunset.

It is unusual for these times of fasting and self-reflection to coincide as the dates of Ramadan change each year. This is a great opportunity for us to

share our thoughts and feelings, and to show empathy to others who may be hungry or tired during this time.
